He has served as president of numerous dental organizations, including the American Academy of Periodontology and the American Academy of Periodontology Foundation. Dr. McGuire received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Baylor University. He received both his D.D.S. and Certificate of Periodontics from the Emory University School of Dentistry. Emory University recognized Dr. McGuire with their Distinguished Alumnus Award in 2009.

While these accomplishments may rival many academicians, perhaps Dr. McGuire's most outstanding achievement is that he accomplished all of this not in the ivory tower of academics, but in full-time private practice.
